14 Mission & 49 Van Ness (stop just across the street), **J Church** (22nd & Church—walk 4 blocks east),

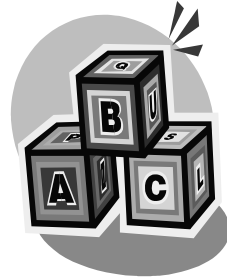

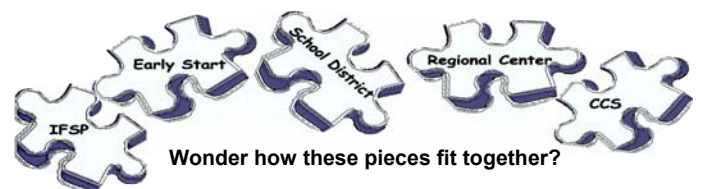
What happens when my child turns three?
